


Various Genre of Essay and their Major Components

Throughout most of your academic career, you will be writing all sorts of essays. These essays do share some common similarities but also have some major components which are only unique to them. We will first define each type of essay in this article and then look at the major components of each essay type.

Commonalities between the different essay types

Before we move towards the different genres of essays and their components, let us first discuss what is common in every essay. Each essay you write as part of your academic writing needs to have a proper introduction. This presents the topic to your reader and also gives some nice background information.

Each essay also has a thesis statement at the end of the introduction. The thesis statement is crucial to your essay because it lets the reader know what to expect in the coming paragraphs. Omitting a thesis statement from your essay can get you below-average marks so make sure to include the statement in all of your essays. All genres of essays have two to three body paragraphs. These paragraphs start off with topic sentences which serve as an overview for the paragraph. All essays have topic sentences and the topic sentences must link back to the thesis statement at the end

A proper conclusion is part of every essay. Here is where you summarize all the key points you have made in your essay. End the conclusion with a recommendation and that is the end of your essay

Argumentative Essay

The purpose of an argumentative essay is to pick a side on a specific topic. You are either in favor of the topic or against the topic. You start off by providing a general description of the topic before providing your stance in the thesis sentence. This stance is backed up by the claims you make in your body paragraph

Each body paragraph has one claim and its corresponding evidence. This evidence is provided from reliable sources such as newspaper articles, research papers, and journal articles.

One body paragraph needs to provide counter-arguments to your stance. The purpose of adding this paragraph is to make sure there is no bias in your paper. Once this paragraph is done, write a conclusion where you summarize all the claims you made and then end it off with a solution or suggestion. Expository Essay

All the information present in an expository essay is based on factual and real-life information. You cannot make up your own ideas and add them to an expository essay. Expository essays can be further divided into different types of essays. These are as follows:

- The descriptive essay is usually the type of expository essay where you define an object and go into detail about the different characteristics and traits.
- In a process or sequential essay, you are tasked to provide a series of steps that need to be completed in order to get something done. An example of this type of expository essay can be a recipe for cake
- The third type of expository essay is a compare and contrast essay. In this type of essay, you are tasked to compare two distinct objects and present the similarities between them. You must also provide the differences between the two objects as well. An example of this type of essay would be comparing the health care in the UK and the U.S
- In a cause-and-effect expository essay, you are expected to mention how one event leads to another event. An example of this type of essay could be how deforestation, which is event 1, can impact biodiversity, which is event 2
- In a problem-solution essay, as the name suggests, you present a problem and then provide the solution for it in a number of body paragraphs

Narrative Essay

The last genre of essay is a narrative essay. A narrative essay is usually written about a personal experience that taught you a valuable life lesson. Just like expository essays, a narrative essay is also nonfiction and the writer has to write about events of their personal life. This helps engage the reader and keeps them hooked to your essay

You can be serious or humorous while writing a narrative essay. But remember, you must appeal to the reader's emotions. This is the central point of the narrative essay and should be mentioned if you want to make the essay as effective as possible.
