## Simple Tips for Writing Essays in English

Learn how to start an essay correctly.

The opening line of any essay is crucial. It sets the tone for the whole paper and can make or help me write my essay it in terms of getting a good grade. Here are some general guidelines on how to open your essays effectively: The best way to start an essay is with a quote from one or more well-known personalities who deal with your topic. For example, if you're writing about human nature, quoting Shakespeare, Freud and Aristotle will be appropriate and impressive. You don't have to do this all the time but as a rule quotes should always be used sparingly – they give emphasis to whatever you say next.

- \* A personal experience where you describe how you got interested in the topic or your first encounter with it.
- \* A fact that was crucial for understanding and developing an idea.
- \* An anecdote (a humorous story) is always good because it excites the reader, makes him/her pay attention to your writing and leads them to expect more to come.

Make sure that when you start your essay with a quote or personal experience, you should give credit where it's due: there must be an attribution of the source of information at the end of the quotation or at least a footnote reference number. This is required by most academic institutions if they want to assess your work properly.

The opening sentence(s) does not have to necessarily follow one of the three above-mentioned patterns but can also be much simpler and show a concrete example. For instance, "Your smile was really nice, I had to approach you first".

Don't try too hard to impress your reader with fancy and complicated words – this may turn off those who aren't native English speakers.. Keep in mind that Steve Jobs (Apple's founder) and Bill Gates (founder of Microsoft) both dropped out of college. So, be yourself and write as you talk!

Make the first sentence(s) powerful but simple – intellectually stimulating, thought-provoking or controversial statements are good examples. But don't overdo it!

The opening paragraph should contain the thesis statement: what <u>cheap essay writing service</u> is being discussed here? Make it clear and explicit.

Remember to introduce your topic, explain the context (if necessary) and then proceed with an in-depth analysis of it or give specific examples that illustrate a crucial aspect of your topic. The conclusion should summarize everything you've said in a nutshell: what conclusions can be drawn from what you've discussed? What does this tell us about human nature? Is it always good to smile? Look at some great opening sentences for inspiration: "The world is full of obvious things which nobody by any chance ever observes" – Sherlock Holmes in Arthur Conan Doyle's 'A Scandal in Bohemia'; "Whenever I read history, I am impressed by its resemblance to the present." - Karl Marx; "For my part, whatever anguish of spirit it may cost, I am willing to know the whole truth; to know the worst and provide for it." – Patrick Henry in a speech during American Revolution; "I have lived on the lip of insanity, wanting to know reasons, knocking on a door." – Edgar Allen Poe. The point is not that you essay writer use these exact sentences when writing your own essays (although that would be better than starting with "First of all...") but that they contain one thing: a powerful opening.
